My cousin Erwin 'Big Ike' Abadie was afflicted with MS late in life. Ikey worked for NASA and was responsible for eleven patents that helped to put a man on the moon. Shortly after Ike became wheelchair dependent, NASA put in some ramps and other accommodations for him, and told Ike that as long as he could make it to his desk he was welcome to work at NASA. Unfortunately, Ike lost his battle with MS in 1991 at the age of 54.

My friend Robert Curtis Huckaby was stricken with MS about 10 years ago. He was 40 years old at the time. The disease has progressed, and Robert has to deal with the limitations it places on him on a daily basis, however thanks to advances in research and medications that were not available in Ike's day, Robert is continuing to work and live a relatively normal life.

MS is a devastating disease. Those of us who are not affected can certainly empathize with those who are, and can be thankful that it's not us who have to deal with it every day. However, scientific research and modern medicine have made significant strides in helping these people live more normal lives. None of this is possible without funding, and it's people like us who make that possible.
