

Fireworks Tutorial - A large button with a glossy effect.

## Tutorial

### 1. Base

Draw out a rectangle 205x74 px and fill it with some dark pink color: #D10287. Then round the corners with a value of 47px

### 2. The upper button

Create a second rectangle on top of the first. To keep a 4px stroke around, the second rectangle must be:  $205 - 8 = 197$ px in width and  $74 - 8 = 66$ px in height. Angle is modified too to 45px.

A **linear gradient** is applied along with an **Inner Bevel** effect.

### 3. The glossy part 1

Duplicate 2 shapes from Step 2, place them on top of each other as in Figure 3, select them and punch `Modify > Combine Paths > Punch` .

4. The glossy part 2

Adjust the punched part on top of the upper button, fill it with white and set the opacity to 35%.

5. Arrow and Text

Add a arrow on the right and some text on the left and you are done!
